CRUFTS TEAM FLYBALL

This is a team competition (knockout). Two teams will compete against each other on separate equipment. The best two of three runs will decide the winner to go into the next round.

Each team shall consist of four handlers and dogs plus two reserves. A club may enter more than one team, and a club may qualify more than one team for the final. No handler or dog can enter/compete in more than one team.

Two teams will be invited from each heat to compete in the semi final/final at Crufts 2018. Once a team has qualified for the semi final/final, further heats cannot be entered or competed in during the current competition year by that team.

This competition is governed by Kennel Club guideline rules for Flyball in force at the time of the heat/final. This event will be run with flat fronted type boxes, which will be provided at the event by the teams entering. Only handlers who are members of the original team, or named as reserves on the entry form, will be allowed to compete in the final at the organiser's discretion (exceptional circumstances).

DIRECTIONS

From M6 Junction 3

Follow signs to Nuneaton (A444). As you near the town centre follow the signs through the town for Burton upon Trent (A444). Leaving the town centre on the "one way" system, move to the right-hand lane on the railway bridge. **The club is signposted on the right as you go down the hill with the entrance via a narrow drive between a row of terraced houses - immediately after the bend, opposite the garage on the corner.

From M69 Junction 2 - Take A5 to Nuneaton. Turn left at the traffic lights by the "Long Shoot" Motel (A47) Take the 2nd left at the island and continue towards the town centre. As you go under the railway bridge, get into the right-hand lane. Turn right at the top of the hill. Then as ** above.
