

NHS Track and Trace Consent



Covid19 GovUK/Legislation requires organisations to keep sufficient information for persons who have visited, for them to be contacted should it be possible they have been in contact with a person who subsequently tested positive for Covid19.

For clarification NHS Trace and Track defines

- Close contact means:
- having face-to-face contact with someone (less than 1 metre away)
- spending more than 15 minutes within 2 metres of someone
- travelling in a car or other small vehicle with someone (even on a short journey) or close to them on a plane
- if you work in – or have recently visited – a setting with other people (for example, a GP surgery, a school, a workplace, or a dog club).

Nuneaton Dog Training Club will only furnish NHS England with sufficient details for them to contact you.

Decisions on any subsequent requirements, i.e. isolation, will be made solely by NHS England.

Nuneaton Dog Training Club will NEVER release any details of any member who tests positive.

At the discretion of the Management Committee Nuneaton Dog Training Club may confirm if an attending member has tested positive for Covid19, providing data protection law is complied with.
